Prepare now so you can complete the 2025–26 FAFSA form as soon as it's available on or before Dec. 1, 2024. Here are some ways you can get ready:

- Create a StudentAid.gov account (if you don't already have one).
- Learn about the <u>documents you may need to fill out the FAFSA form</u>.
- Determine your <u>dependency status</u> and whether your parent(s) or spouse will be required to contribute information on your FAFSA form.
- If you're a dependent student, use the Who's My FAFSA Parent? wizard to identify which parent(s) will be a required contributor on your form.

TAP - New York's tuition assistance program

Don't forget New York State Financial Aid if you plan to go to college here in NYS. Eligible students can receive up to \$5,665 to help cover tuition expenses.
